Minority Report

April 15, 2018 Numbers 13:1-33; 14:1-10

☐ Mission IMPASSABLE

- God's plans are not based on popular opinion
- "And the Lord spoke to Moses, saying" Numbers 13:1
- We must develop the HABIT of speaking to God
- We must get our marching orders from God
- "Send men to spy out the land of Canaan..." Numbers 13:2a
- God wants to send **MEN** to see the promise
- "Taste and see that the Lord is good. Oh, the joys of those who take refuge in him!" Psalm 34:8
- He wants men to have the **VISION** for the family
- Unfortunately, Many are called, but those that choose are few
- "...which I am giving to the children of Israel; from each tribe of their fathers you shall send a man, every one a leader among them." – Numbers 13:2
- Men see(d) the vision, God has the supervision and the woman supports the vision (Genesis 2)
- God wants men to carry the **PROMISE** of the children
- "So Moses sent them...according to the command of the Lord, all of them men who were heads of the children of Israel" – Numbers 13:3
- Leaders represent their families; You cannot bypass the will of God

☐ Mission IMPOSSIBLE

- "Then Moses sent them to spy out the land of Canaan...and see what the land is like..." Numbers 13:17-18
- Canaan (merchant or trader) situated along the eastern Mediterranean Sea. A dry, mountainous, rocky, but contained many fertile farmlands in river valleys and coastal plains
- Moses sends them on a reconnaissance mission
- **Reconnaissance** military observation of a region to locate an enemy or ascertain strategic features; preliminary surveying or research.
- He sends them to SURVEY the land then he SURVEYS them
- "Then they came to the Valley of Eshcol, and there cut down a branch with one cluster of grapes...
 They also brought some of the pomegranates and figs... And they returned from spying out the land after forty days." Numbers 13:23-25

SERMON NOTES

- Eschol cluster of grapes
- God sends them into the vineyard! (Matthew 9:35-38)
- Don't let the <u>FACTS</u> disrupt the <u>TRUTH</u>
- "Then they told him, and said: "We went to the land where you sent us. It truly flows with milk and honey, and this *is* its fruit." Numbers 13:27
- "Nevertheless the people who dwell in the land are strong; the cities are fortified and very large; moreover we saw the descendants of Anak there." Numbers 13:8
- They didn't come back **FRUITLESS**, they came back **FAITHLESS**
- Your **FAITH** will affect your **FRUIT!**

☐ Mission "HIM" POSSIBLE

- "Then Caleb quieted the people before Moses, and said, "Let us go up at once and take possession, for we are well able to overcome it." – Numbers 13:30
- Caleb had a different spirit!
- "And they gave the children of Israel a bad report..." Numbers 13:32
- They were content with telling <u>GOD</u> how big their <u>PROBLEMS</u> were rather than telling their <u>PROBLEMS</u> how big their <u>GOD</u> was
- Their problem was their **PERCEPTION**
- Our fruitfulness is largely based on how we perceive things
- WEEPING + COMPLAINING = PITY PARTY (Numbers 14:1-4)
- But Joshua and Caleb gave a minority report!
- "...The land we passed through to spy out is an exceedingly good land. " Numbers 14:7b
- They confirmed the PROMISE
- "If the Lord delights in us, then He will bring us into this land and give it to us, 'A land which flows with milk and honey." – Numbers 14:8
- They confirmed their **FAITH**
- "What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?" Romans 8:31
- "But Jesus looked at them and said to them, "With men this is impossible, but with God all things are possible." – Matthew 19:26
