Greatness Is Your Destiny

“Then the LORD God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to tend and keep it.” - Genesis 2:15

Lucifer - Ezekiel 28:7, Isaiah 14:12

Man - Psalm 8:5, Hebrews 2:7

God created a lesser creature, man, in order to demonstrate His greater **GLORY**.

“Then the LORD God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to tend and keep it. And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, “Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat; but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die.” – Genesis 2:15-17

“Now the serpent was more cunning than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said to the woman, “Has God indeed said, ‘You shall not eat of every tree of the garden’?” – Genesis 3:1

Man was given the responsibility of **PROVISION** and **PROTECTION** in the garden.

A kingdom man is a man who comes under the comprehensive **RULE** of God.

The Devil kept “God” and dropped “**LORD**”

God created Adam and all the Adams since for **GREATNESS**.

You were not created just to be a **MALE**; you were created to be a **GREAT MAN**.

“Then God blessed them, and God said to them, “Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth.” – **Genesis 1:28**

God wants you to be GREAT! (Genesis 12:2, II Samuel 7:9, Genesis 18:19)

If you are a Christian, you have been chosen not only to be **SAVED** in heaven but to be **GREAT** in history.

“And He said to her, “What do you wish?” She said to Him, “Grant that these two sons of mine may sit, one on Your right hand and the other on the left, in Your kingdom.” But Jesus answered and said, “You do not know what you ask. Are you able to drink the cup that I am about to drink, and be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with?” They said to Him, “We are able.” So He said to them, “You will



indeed drink My cup, and be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with; but to sit on My right hand and on My left is not Mine to give, but it is for those for whom it is prepared by My Father.” And when the ten heard it, they were greatly displeased with the two brothers. But Jesus called them to Himself and said, “You know that the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and those who are great exercise authority over them. Yet it shall not be so among you; but whoever desires to become great among you, let him be your servant. And whoever desires to be first among you, let him be your slave—just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many.” – **Matthew 20:21-28**

When God ever used a man in the Bible, He always called them to do something **MORE** than they thought they could do.

Moses was the **meekest** man that ever lived, but God made him great.

“So the Lord said to Moses: “See, I have made you as God to Pharaoh, and Aaron your brother shall be your prophet. You shall speak all that I command you. And Aaron your brother shall tell Pharaoh to send the children of Israel out of his land.” – **Exodus 7:1-2**

Analogy: The *breaking* of a horse. A broken horse does not lose its power or strength; it just has its will adjusted.

God will make you **MEEK** so He can make you **GREAT**.

The biggest Christian man is the one who has gone **LOW** before God.

Greatness is when you achieve the ____REASON____ for which you were created and maximize its **INFLUENCE** in the lives of others.

You are not called to be ORDINARY, you are called to be EXTRAORDINARY!

Shamgar was extraordinary...

“After him was Shamgar the son of Anath, who killed six hundred men of the Philistines with an ox goad; and he also delivered Israel.” – **Judges 3:31**

“In the days of Shamgar, son of Anath, in the days of Jael, the highways were deserted, and the travelers walked along the byways.” – **Judges 5:6**

Shamgar – “The one who listens to God”
