COURAGEOUS FAITH (PART II)

May 10, 2020 I Kings 17

□ COURAGEOUS FAITH WILL PREPARE DILIGENTLY

- "So Saul clothed David with his armor, and he put a bronze helmet on his head; he also clothed him with a coat of mail." I Samuel 17:38
- You can't be courageous with someone else's armor
- "I cannot walk with these, for I have not tested them." So David took them off." I Samuel 17:39
- You need to take off the EXPECTATIONS of others
- David didn't have **EXPERIENCE** in Saul's armor
- A key to PREPARATION is knowing your LIMITATIONS
- "Then he took his staff in his hand; and he chose for himself five smooth stones from the brook, and put them in a shepherd's bag, in a pouch which he had, and his sling was in his hand..." I Samuel 17:40a
- You need to take **INVENTORY** of what you have that God can use
- "After him was Shamgar the son of Anath, who killed six hundred men of the Philistines with an ox goad; and he also delivered Israel." Judges 3:31
- David was headed into HEATED BATTLE against a FIERCE OPPONENT with a SHEPHERD'S BAG not a WARRIOR'S AMOR!
- "And Samuel said to Jesse, 'Are all the young men here?' Then he said, 'There remains yet the youngest, and there he is, keeping the sheep.'" I Samuel 16:11

□ COURAGEOUS FAITH WILL ENGAGE CONFIDENTLY

- "...and his sling was in his hand. And he drew near to the Philistine." I Samuel 17:40b
- We need to draw near; not withdraw; you cannot <u>CONQUER</u> what you will not <u>CONFRONT</u>
- That you have **STEADILY**, God to use **MIGHTILY**
- "And the LORD said to Gideon, "The people who are with you are too many for Me to give the Midianites into their hands, lest Israel claim glory for itself against Me, saying, 'My own hand has saved me." Judges 7:2
- You may have **TOO MUCH** to give God glory
- The LORD will **DIMINISH** your resources to **MAGNIFY** his glory
- "Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us" Ephesians 3:20
- "And when the Philistine looked about and saw David, he disdained him; for he was only a youth, ruddy and good-looking." I Samuel 17:42
- David, like may young people, are looked over and underestimated
- "Let no one despise your youth, but be an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity." I Timothy 4:12

SERMON NOTES

- God has a **PURPOSE** and **PLAN** for our youth!
- "Then Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed him in the midst of his brothers; and the Spirit of the LORD came upon David from that day forward. So Samuel arose and went to Ramah." – I Samuel 16:13
- David was CONFIDENT because he was ANOINTED
- Anointing means to be SET APART and ENDUED with power
- Lack of PURPOSE breeds INSECURITY

□ COURAGEOUS FAITH WILL COME OUT VICTORIOUSLY

- "Then David said to the Philistine, "'You come to me with a sword, with a spear, and with a javelin..." I Samuel 17:37a
- The enemy (Goliath) has short, medium and long range weaponry at his disposal...he'll use his whole arsenal!
- "...But I come to you in the name of the Lord of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied." I Samuel 17:37
- David is CONFIDENT; not ARROGANT (Ephesians 3:12)
- "Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us." I John 5:14
- "So David prevailed over the Philistine with a sling and a stone, and struck the Philistine and killed him. But *there was* no sword in the hand of David." I Samuel 17:50
- Like David, you will come of victoriously when you have courageous faith
